

Help Rebuild Virginia's Transportation Plan

Virginia Transportation Plan Meetings

The Commonwealth Transportation Board (CTB) is committed to delivering a realistic and achievable transportation plan for fiscal years 2003-2008. Because of the economic downturn and other factors, it is necessary to downsize the current transportation plan, which includes over 1,400 projects. It is anticipated that many projects now in the Virginia Department of Transportation's Six-Year Improvement Plan might be delayed or eliminated.

Your feedback on which transportation projects to move forward is important to help the CTB prioritize projects in the Six-Year Improvement Plan, also known as the Virginia Transportation Development Plan. The CTB is hosting public meetings in each of VDOT's nine districts to gather your comments. At these meetings, VDOT staff will outline the reasons for the need to downsize the plan.
